

About the Festival

Music Celebrations International would like to invite your ensemble to perform in the Beethoven 250 Orchestra Festival June 25-30, 2020 in Vienna as part of Beethoven's 250th Birthday Celebration taking place throughout Germany and Austria. Select orchestras will be featured in performance in Vienna's historic Musikverein. All participating orchestras are selected by application process through Music Celebrations.

Vienna, affectionately known as the "Capital of Classical Music", holds a special place in the hearts of musicians as it was here where composers like Mozart, Haydn, Schubert, and Beethoven established their musical careers. Beethoven said of this city, "Perhaps heaven will permit me not to have to give up Vienna as my permanent abode." Countless other composers and musicians have at one point called Vienna home as it has continued to embrace its musical tradition and propel classical music into the present day and future.

Highlights of Vienna include the majestic Schönbrunn Palace, Burgkapelle (home of the Vienna Boys Choir), Vienna City Cemetery, St. Stephen's Cathedral, Beethoven's apartment in Heilgenstadt, and much more! There is no better place in the world to celebrate Beethoven's historic 250th birthday than Vienna and the Musikverein!



Day One: Monday, June 22, 2020

• Depart via scheduled air service to Prague, Czech Republic


Day Two: Tuesday, June 23

- Arrive in Prague
- Meet your MCI Tour Manager, who will assist the group to awaiting chartered motorcoach
- Transfer to Prague via Terezin
- Excursion to Terezin (former fortress and Nazi Concentration Camp for children), including entrance to the fortress and Museum of the Ghetto. Terezin offers poignant insights for musicians because of the music written here by prisoners
- Continue to Prague with a panoramic tour of the city upon arrival
- Late afternoon hotel check-in
- Evening Welcome Dinner included, and overnight









Prague achieved much of its present glory in the 14th century, during the long reign of Charles IV. During the Middle Ages, Prague enjoyed a golden age - a time when Prague was larger than Paris or London! The Hapsburgs also left their artistic and architectural mark. Today, Prague is universally declared one of the most beautiful cities in Europe

Day Three: Wednesday, June 24

- Breakfast included at the hotel
- Morning guided tour of Prague that includes seeing the Charles Bridge, Old Town Square, the Tyn Church, the Astronomical Clock, and the Jewish Quarter. Also visit the Castle District, where entrance is included to Hradcany Castle, St. Vitus Cathedral, the Old Royal Palace, the Golden Lane, and Daliborka Tower. Entrance is included to the Lobkowicz Palace to view original scores and manuscripts by Beethoven, including his 4th & 5th symphonies
- Lunch, on own
- Performance in Prague as part of the American Celebration of Music in Czech Republic*
- Evening dinner included, and overnight











Church of St. Simon and Jude

Sir Bohuslav from Olbramovice founded a hospital in 1354 in the space where the Church of St. Simon & Jude is located today. As a part of the hospital complex, a chapel was necessary. Before 1620, the chapel was rebuilt and enlarged by the non-Catholic churches to such degree that it became a competitor to the main cathedral of Prague - St. Vitus.

Since its early reconstruction it has undergone numerous renovations. Recent reconstruction has added modern amenities such as floor heating which allows all-year services and concerts in the church. The church is a home to the Prague Symphony Orchestra which uses the space for its chamber music projects. The late Baroque church organ was played by Mozart and Haydn. It is still functional and famous for its excellent authentic sound.

Day Four: Thursday, June 25

- Breakfast included at the hotel, followed by check-out
- Morning transfer to Vienna
- Lunch, on own
- Stop at the Vienna City Cemetery to visit the graves of Beethoven, Strauss, Brahms, Schubert and the Mozart Memorial
- Take a short panoramic tour of Vienna that acquaints visitors with the main attractions and landmarks
- Evening dinner included, and overnight









Vienna is still considered the music capital of the world. It is a city of refined tastes, grace, style and unmatched artistic accomplishments. For a thousand years, Vienna was the capital of the far-flung Holy Roman and Hapsburg empires. Though its people and ways have changed, Vienna has retained its imperial monuments, not as reminders of past glories, but as living symbols of its present freedom

Day Five: Friday, June 26

- Breakfast included at the hotel
- Half-day guided tour of Historical Vienna includes the Ringstráße, Imperial Palace, State Opera, Town Hall, Burgkapelle (home of the Vienna Boys Choir), Palace Stables, Strauß Monument, and entrance to Schönbrunn Palace, built by the Hapsburgs in imitation of Versailles
- Lunch, on own
- Afternoon half-day guided tour of Musical Vienna includes entrance to the Haus der Musik (House of Music), a modern interactive sound museum, with floors dedicated to the Vienna Philharmonic and The Great Composers. The Musical Vienna tour concludes with a visit (entrance included) to the Beethoven Heiligenstadt apartment
- Evening dinner included, and overnight

Day Six: Saturday, June 27

- Breakfast included at the hotel
- Rehearsal in the Golden Hall of the Musikverein
- Excursion to Kahlenberg to walk the "Beethoven trail" (a route he often walked), and visit the Vienna woods
- Lunch, on own
- Next, visit the Pasqualati House and Museum
- Evening dinner included, and overnight







Day Seven: Sunday, June 28

- Breakfast included at the hotel
- Lunch, on own
- Afternoon time at leisure
- Evening dinner included
- Warm-up in the Grand Hall of the Musikverein
- Festival Concert in the Golden Hall of the Musikverein
- Overnight at the hotel

Day Eight: Monday, June 29

- Breakfast included at the hotel, followed by check-out
- Transfer to the Vienna Airport for return flight home












Musikverein

The Musikverein is a world-renowned venue located in the heart of Vienna and home to the Vienna Philharmonic. Due to its highly regarded acoustics, the Musikverein is considered one of the finest concert halls in the world. For over 146 years, the concert hall has hosted countless stars of classical music. Construction spanned over a three-year period and was made possible through an historic decree by Emperor Franz Joseph in 1857. Inspired by classical Greek architecture, the Musikverein is considered as the most beautiful concert building in the world.


