Message from Dr. Richard Loheyde, Director and Conductor

Please include the following elements in your brief weekly message to your ensemble. The goal is to help students stay prepared, build strong practice habits, and deepen their musicianship. Your message should be no more than 250 words.

- 1. **Practice Tips** Share 1-2 practical, actionable tips students can apply during their practice sessions. Examples: metronome strategies, focused warm-ups, tone/bow development exercises, or breathing techniques.
- 2. **Weekly Practice Assignments** Provide clear and specific guidance on what students should work on before the next rehearsal. Include: measure numbers, particular sections to polish, suggested tempos, and any technique reminders that will help them prepare effectively.
- 3. **Preparation for Upcoming Rehearsal** Let students know what to expect so they arrive ready to play. Note: the repertoire to be rehearsed, any part or seating updates, special instructions, and reminders to bring pencils, music, or other materials.

Aim for a message that is encouraging, clear, and concise—no more than 250 words—to ensure students and families stay informed, focused, and inspired each week.
