TOUR FUNDRAISING

Three Ways YOU Can Fundraise for Tour

1. Sell season sponsorships and concert program ads for Dec, Feb Concerts and Red Gala
2. Sell tickets for Winter drawing (Trip for 2 to Hawaii – airfare & hotel!)
3. Donations to NVYS via the GiveGuide or Red Gala

How Students Accumulate Funds for Tour

First \$300 = NVYS Family Commitment

\$301 – entire cost of tour = 100% goes to tour

Who Can Fundraise? Anyone going on tour (students, parents, siblings, grandparents). Each tour participant will have their own tour fundraising account.

Do parents and siblings on tour need to fulfill a \$300 family commitment? No. Each family, no matter how many children are NVYS members, is only responsible for a \$300 commitment. Siblings, Parents and others will have the following fundraising tier:

Tier 1: \$1 – entire cost of tour = 100% goes towards tour

When will NVYS payout the funds I raise for tour? All tour fundraising will be completed April 15, 2020. Any outstanding balance will be your responsibility and due May 1, 2020.

What if I raise more than the cost of tour? The money beyond tour would go back to support NVYS.

Example of tour fundraising

Alex sells a half page concert program ad to Pretty Good Yogurt	\$600
Half page ad season sponsorship to XYZ Orthodontics	\$900
Quarter page ad to Jorge’s Sports Center	\$150
Grandma Sue donated \$300 to NVYS via the GiveGuide	\$300
(Grandma Sue also bought a VIP ticket to the Red Gala for \$150 but that does not go toward tour)	
Alex sold \$600 in raffle tickets to friends and family	<u>\$600</u>
Total Fundraising	\$2,550
Minus Family Commitment	<u>-300</u>
Subtotal	\$2,150
Alex’s Total Tour Account	\$2,150
